Fall Wine Club

We pulled out the stops on this shipment to include only 2008 wines that won Gold Medals. Two of them even got Best of Class of Region awards. We figured that we couldn't go wrong by making sure that our best customers ended up with some of the best wines of the 2008 vintage before they are gone.

2008 Merlot – Gold at Orange County Fair 2010. This is a velvety and powerful Merlot with aspects of dusty cocoa. Best of the Foothills? Maybe. Enjoy it with lasagna or with pot roast. Or just enjoy it on the patio with friends. Or by yourself. Or whatever.

2008 Mourvedre – Best of Class of Region State Fair 2010. One of our flagships, this wine has a lovely medium-weight body and smooth tannins along with its signature white pepper finish. This can pair pretty darned well with BBQ'd lamb or with olives and cheese on your kitchen table. Remember: when you run out - you have No Ved.

2008 Cabernet Franc – Best of Class of Region and Gold Medal El Dorado County Fair 2011. This wine earned that title by being perhaps the Best Cab Franc from the Foothills. Maybe Ever. So There. The last of it goes to the wine club. We suggest enjoying this rich and luscious wine during the most special part of your life called "not working".

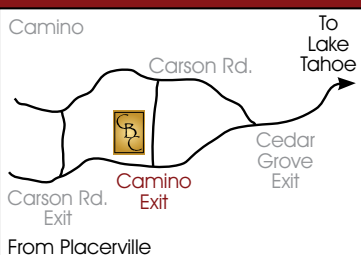
